Happens. And when it does, we are doing our best here at **BARK BARN** to keep an eye; making sure everyone is happy & healthy, not only on the exterior but also the interior. Loose stools can start from being given “table food” from mom and dad right before drop off. It may also be from a recent change in diet, antibiotic administration, eating something they shouldn’t have, recent storms, or some puppies just naturally have a nervous gut. The pup may look and act like they’re having an absolute blast here at **BARK BARN**, yet on the inside their gut may be doing the cha-cha from having “the butterflies” or from just being “too excited.” Boarding is a very common atmosphere where a pup can end up having loose stools *{typically seen between days 3-5... or pups with longer stays.}* Simply because they are out of their everyday routine and mingling around with other pups. Inflammation of the gut can go from not being a big deal, *if treated immediately*, to a very big deal if ignored. This is why we suggest starting the pup on a good probiotic like “Pro-Pectalin” or “FortiFlora” at the *first signs* of loose stool. Both of these products are over the counter (*I get mine from Chewy.com*) Both are recommended by Veterinarians and are also great for pups of all ages and sizes. Canned 100% Pumpkin is also excellent! And sometimes a bland diet of boiled chicken & rice is needed, being it is gentler on the digestive system than most kibble. Your baby is our #1 concern, and we want to do everything in our power to make their sleepover with us *The Best Day Ever!!* 😊
